

THE MARIANA REMPLE AWARDS

Cadette, Senior, Ambassador or Juliette Girl Scouts of Douglas County

These awards are given in honor of long-time Lawrence Girl Scout leader, trainer and mentor, Mariana Remple, who passed away on September 19, 2000, leaving a legacy of dedication to Hidden Valley. Mariana, one of the founders of Hidden Valley Camp, became its main steward for over 40 years. She served on the board of directors, and as the Site Chair, oversaw the daily operations, development and management of our beloved camp. Mariana always encouraged girls to “reach for the stars” and we would like to do the same with these awards.

Girls may use the money however they desire. These awards do not have to be a GS-sponsored event, and an event is *NOT* required to receive this award. Through these awards, girls are encouraged to take advantage of leadership trainings, Destinations or other projects that will broaden their perspectives and increase their leadership potential. Please note that more consideration will be given to applications for a specific event or training.

Because of Mariana’s love and dedication to Hidden Valley, we especially want to assist girls that have had many and varied experiences at Hidden Valley and can put their knowledge and leadership skills to use for the benefit of the Camp, its users or the wildlife. **Two awards of \$150 each** will be awarded by FHV to individual Girl Scouts each fiscal year (July 1 through June 30).

Requirements for the Mariana Remple Awards are:

1. Be a registered Girl Scout of Douglas County (SU #716), either in a troop or as a Juliette.
2. To submit the attached form and a one-page essay, “**Why I Love Hidden Valley**”. The form is also available on the Friends website: www.friendshv.org.
3. To have **attended** at least **one** Friends of **Hidden Valley Workday during the past 12 months**.
4. Must submit this form and your essay *anytime* during the year *prior to April 1st*.
(Please note, only two awards will be awarded each fiscal year. You may check the website for availability.)

Applicants will be notified of acceptance or denial of award within two weeks of the receipt of the completed form. Awards will be given at a Service Unit 716 meeting.
